At first glance he looks like any other rancher, but four years ago Cody Busch was in an automobile accident that resulted in his right leg being amputated above the knee. He has a small ranch in Glencoe, OK where he raises calves along with his five year old daughter, Chelsea.

Cody has struggled, his wife died from heart problems just prior the accident but he remains optimistic. He works for the Oklahoma State University Beef Cattle Center as a feed mill operator when not tending to his calves. His goal in life is to take his calves to a large 2,000 acre cattle ranch someday.

Cody said, “Limbs for Life helped to relieve a huge financial burden on me. Because I have a prosthetic limb I can return to my dream of being a rancher and caring for my daughter.”

Traumatic amputations usually result directly from car, factory, farm, or power tool accidents. Natural disasters, war, and terrorist attacks can also cause traumatic amputations. Cody is one of the approximately 1.7 million people living with limb loss in the United States. Many of these amputees will be unable to afford proper prosthetic care due to the lack of financial resources. Limbs for Life Foundation is the financial bridge for these amputees to receive a prosthetic limb.

Even with insurance, it is devastating for some people to pay their portion of the cost for a prosthetic limb. Also, a prosthetic will need new components or need to be replaced after a couple of years. Maintaining a prosthetic throughout a lifetime cost thousands of dollars for a patient. Amputees generally need numerous prosthetic limbs throughout their life and some insurance companies will only pay for one! Many people simply go without a limb, leaving them to rely on others for help with everyday tasks.
