A Few Facts

There are approximately 1.7 million people in the United States currently living with limb loss. That's one in every 200 Americans. About 185,000 amputations are performed every year. The average prosthetic limb costs \$20,000, with some costing over \$100,000 through insurance. Limbs for Life can provide a fully functioning prosthetic limb for an average of \$2,000 because of donated time and componentry.

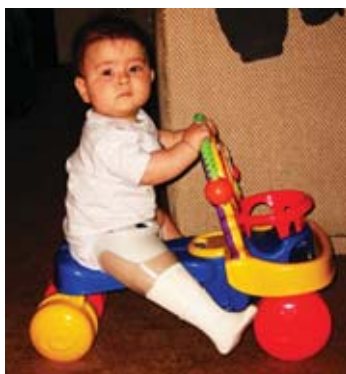
