"Limitations are depressing and I want to be independent, not a burden." With her new limb, Edna can continue to live alone and care for herself, get outside and garden, and go to church. Social isolation encountered after limb loss is a significant barrier to recovery and rehabilitation. Removal of this barrier through provision of a prosthetic limb allows the individual to get out and enjoy the company of others, engage in their community and resume activities they enjoyed before limb loss, all crucial to positive outcomes for the amputee and their family.
